The following instructions are offered in order to create a Facebook application to add links to a Facebook compatible version of your QuestionPoint Qwidget.

In order to build a Facebook application you must accept the Facebook application terms and conditions. It is up to your library to review and agree to the Facebook terms and conditions.

STEP 1

Create an HTML page called fb.html

STEP 2

Place the edited qwidget code snippet as shown into the fb.html page between the body tags

STEP 3

Copy the fb.html page to a public web server

Test to be sure that -the qwidget is visible on the page you have created through an accessible URL such as <http://xxxxx.xxx/fb.html>

You will need this URL to be active for step 4.

Begin the Facebook application building process, using the Facebook Developer tools.

STEP 4

Create the Facebook application

4.1 Fill out the Canvas page. When your done, click on Basic

Create a name for your FB qwidget's home directory

This must have 7 or more characters (no numbers)

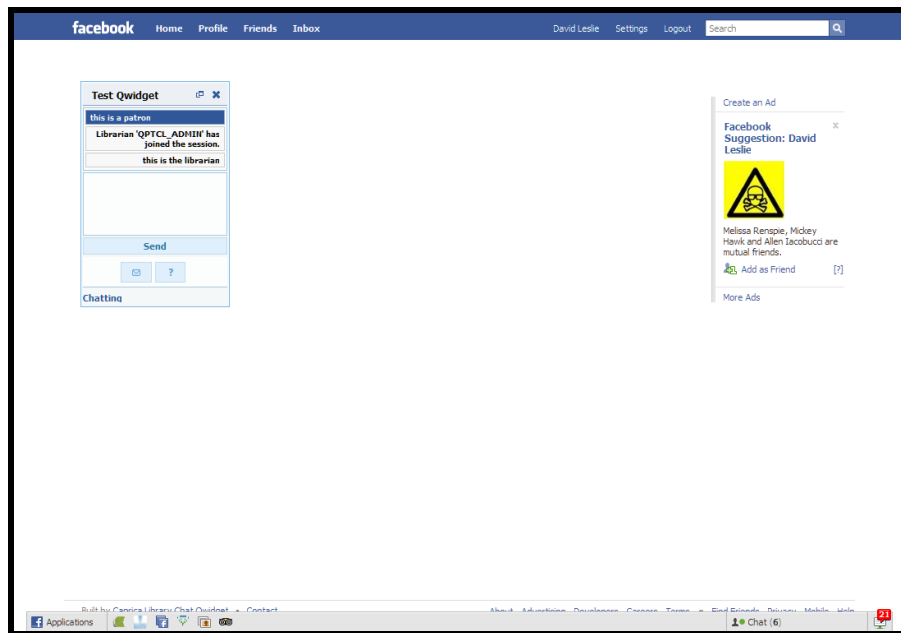

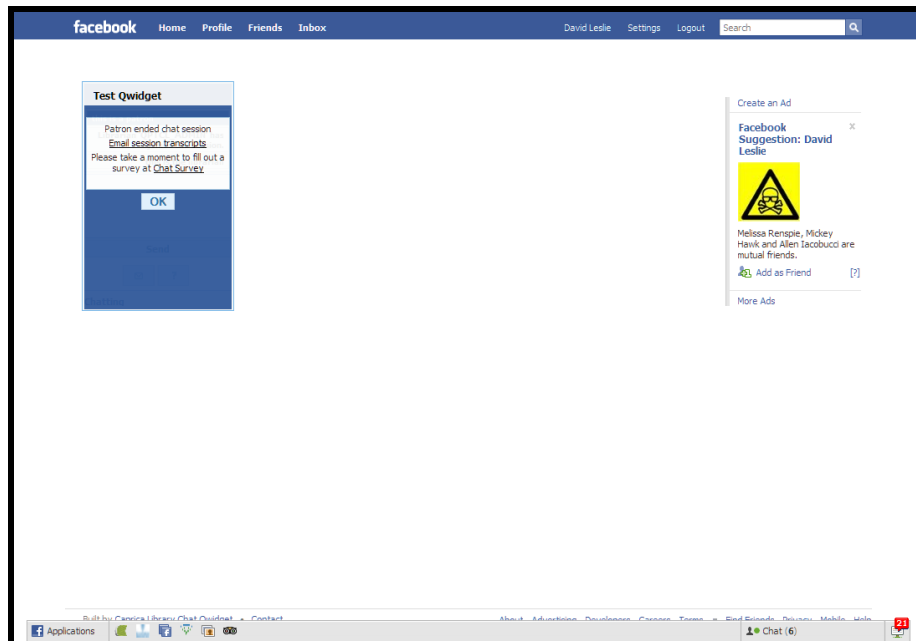
